# From the Board Chair

Dear Amigos Members, Partners, and Community:

2021-22 was a return to more normal operations for many libraries, though we have all emerged from the past two years with new models of service, new convictions and commitments, and renewed interest in connecting with our communities. We remain thankful and inspired by the work happening in libraries across the Amigos network – and more and more interested in being a valued partner in your future.

As part of our own work, this year the Board of Directors and Amigos staff completed a new [Amigos Library Services Strategic Plan to 2025](#). The goals and strategies for this new plan focus on four key themes: Member-Led and Member-Centered; a Valued Partner; Focus on Libraries and Library Staff; and Organizational Excellence. I hope you and your colleagues will take a moment to explore the plan and consider ways that we can deliver on these goals for your library.

The Board of Directors also completed a revision to Amigos' membership fees, focusing on ways to make participating in Amigos more equitable and understandable across different library types. We thank the membership for their approval of the new fees structure, which combines all libraries into a single scale and bases fees on a library's operating budget data as published by National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), a state library, or as self-reported by the institution to Amigos.

Some additional highlights from this membership year:

Amigos continued our record of popular and high-quality online training this year. Online topical conferences, the annual member conference, Know and Go sessions (all free to members) and our discounted educational courses attracted over 4,700 attendees and learners. The Community Conversations series (free to members) came into full swing with five informative discussions bringing together over 400 leaders from 180 of our member libraries.

Amigos' SimplyE work continues to grow. With expanded eligibility for the Texas State Library and Archives Commission's E-Read Texas Program, Amigos now hosts SimplyE services for over 180 libraries. Amigos' partnership with the Arizona State Library, Archives, and Public Records provides SimplyE support for the Ak-Chin Indian Community Library, the Nogales Santa Cruz County Public Library, and more.

As part of the Missouri State Library's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding for libraries, Amigos helped grow the Missouri Libraries 2 Go consortium to 109 public libraries sharing over 77,000 ebooks and audiobooks.

Amigos supported several organizations' return to in-person and hybrid conferences, including support for the Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services, the Library Marketing and Communications Conference, the Louisiana Library Association, the Missouri Library Association, and the Oklahoma Library Association.

Our core services – including our group purchasing program, courier service, and resource sharing programs – continue to fulfill essential needs for libraries.

The 2021-22 membership year concludes my two-plus years as Chair of the Amigos Board of Directors. It has been a great privilege and joy to serve on the very collegial Amigos Board. I want to thank my fellow board members from the past three Boards for their commitment and dedication to this work and the membership for their support and engagement.

We thank you for your continued partnership and we look forward to more work ahead!

## **Member-Led/Member-Centered : Member voices shape programs and services. Amigos' programs and services reflect the needs and interests of our members.**

Amigos' member-exclusive Community Conversations highlight important topics in a peer-to-peer learning environment. Thank you to member leaders Cindy Dudenhoffer (University of Missouri), Jennifer Eldridge (Longview Public Library), Susan Garrison (Rice University, Fondren Library), Barbara Glackin (Southeast Missouri State University), Dean Hendrix (University of Texas at San Antonio), Tracey Mendoza (University of the Incarnate Word), Cindy Thompson (University of Missouri – Kansas City), Roosevelt Weeks (Austin Public Library), and Lisa Wells (Pioneer Library System) for leading and facilitating these important conversations about library staffing, communications, accreditation, and more. Over 400 leaders from 183 member libraries attended Community Conversations in member year 2021-22.

The Amigos Board of Directors convened a Dues and Fees Committee (Barbara Glackin, Southeast Missouri State University; Tracey Mendoza, University of the Incarnate Word; Mary Moroney, Eastern Oklahoma Library System; and Britt Anne Murphy, Hendrix College) to review the organization's member fees. After a year of dedicated work, and with the approval of the membership in June 2022, Amigos introduced a new member fee schedule that makes membership more equitable and accessible for public, academic, school, and special libraries. Member fees are now based on a library's operating budget data as published by National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), a state library, or as self-reported by the institution to Amigos.

Amigos' sponsorship of the 2021 Electronic Resources and Libraries (ER&L) Conference provided ten individuals from Amigos member libraries - Abilene Christian University; Arkansas Tech University; Doña Ana Community College; Missouri Valley College; the University of Oklahoma; and the University of Texas Medical Branch - with free conference registration and access to e-resources management education.

## **A Valued Partner : Amigos is a partner, first and foremost – pursuing programs and services that benefit members, partners, and the wider library community.**

Through Member Discount Services (MDS) group purchasing program, 334 libraries obtained specially negotiated member discounts on subscriptions to databases and journals from Amigos' vendor partners.

Over 268,000 library items shipped through the Trans-Amigos Express (TAE) courier program in membership year 2021-22 and TAE welcomed six new libraries - Forest Hill Public Library; Haltom City Public Library; Richland Hills Public Library; Temple Public Library; The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley – Brownsville; and Watauga Public Library. With a flat-rate annual fee, TAE saved participants thousands of dollars on packaging and shipping while providing rapid pick-up and delivery of interlibrary loan materials. TExpress, a partnership between the Texas State Library and Archives Commission and Amigos, provided courier service to 203 participating libraries within Texas.

Over 300 Amigos member libraries participated in the Amigos Resource Sharing Agreement, accessing free loans and copies from member libraries and another 200 libraries in the South Central and Southwest regions of the United States.

# A Valued Partner : Amigos is a partner, first and foremost – pursuing programs and services that benefit members, partners, and the wider library community.

Amigos continues its support of SimplyE, an open source service developed by libraries for libraries to aggregate library digital collections and improve patrons’ reading and listening experience for ebooks and audiobooks. Amigos’ partnership with the Texas State Library and Archives Commission’s [E-Read Texas program](#) now provides SimplyE service to over 180 public libraries serving communities of under 100,000 or with electronic collection expenditures of less than \$100,000. Working with the Arizona State Library, Archives, and Public Records, Amigos has helped expand the [Reading Arizona](#) project by providing SimplyE services to public and tribal libraries across the state.

## **A Valued Partner : Amigos is a partner, first and foremost – pursuing programs and services that benefit members, partners, and the wider library community.**

The Amigos-administered Missouri Libraries 2 Go group, made up of public libraries with similar interests and patron populations, continued to work together to share a collection of over 77,000 ebooks and audiobooks. With American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding from the Missouri State Library, MOLIB2GO includes 109 public libraries including six new members - Puxico Public Library; Ralls County Library; Rich Hill Memorial Library; Robertson Memorial Library; Seymour Community Library; and Sweet Springs Public Library.

By way of a partnership with the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Amigos member libraries can become an acknowledged DOAJ supporter at a 30% discount to help sustain the independent open scholarship community-curated online directory of indexed, peer-reviewed resources.

Amigos supported events and conferences for six professional organizations, including the Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services; Library Marketing and Communications Conference; Missouri Library Association; Oklahoma Library Association; St. Louis Regional Library Network; and Wyoming Library Association.



## Focus on Libraries and Library Staff : Amigos supports and promotes member libraries and the growth and development of library staff.

Members engaged in seventy-five scheduled courses, forty-one free Know & Go sessions, three online conferences, and the 2022 Annual Amigos Member Conference. Amigos reached more than 4,700 registered attendees and learners through continuing education and training opportunities.

As a benefit of membership, over 189 member libraries accessed a free single-user sign-on to the ALA RDA Toolkit, an essential package of data elements, guidelines, and instructions for creating library resource metadata that are well-formed for user-focused linked data applications.

Amigos was honored to host Kaetrena Davis Kendrick's "[Renewal Colloquium](#)" as a special event for member libraries. Kendrick's session imparted wisdom and insight gained from her landmark research on low morale in the library workplace.

Posting openings on the Amigos Job Bank provides member libraries free access to a popular site with those searching for employment. Over 100 positions received national visibility for openings reaching job seekers across the country.
