Dear Amigos Members, Partners, and Community:

The 2023-24 membership year marks my second year as chair of the Amigos Board of Directors and another year of continued action and movement across the Amigos network as we strive further toward our Strategic Plan to 2025.

With a Board of Directors representing states and library types from across our region, we have pursued a goal of member-led and member-centered. This year, the Board met in St. Louis, Dallas, and Albuquerque, providing opportunities to visit and meet with the staffs at Washington University in St. Louis, Farmers Branch Manske Library in Texas, and the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Library in New Mexico.

Amigos continues to pursue its role as a valued partner. Amigos saw to completion its work with SimplyE, as it completed a final year of support for the Texas State Library and Archives Commission's E-Read Texas Program, the Arizona State Library, Archives, and Public Records' SimplyE initiative for tribal communities, and direct hosting for several public libraries in Texas and Missouri. As Amigos winds down its SimplyE work, it can celebrate eight years of valued service to over 200 libraries across the region. As it pivots away from one technology service, Amigos has undertaken a new opportunity to partner with libraries as a hosting provider for Hyku, a digital repository that provides a robust and flexible platform for institutions to manage and provide access to digital content. Amigos has already worked with several test libraries and continues to promote and grow the Hyku service with pilot libraries across the region. And Amigos continues to serve as a partner to regional groups and associations, including the Missouri Libraries 2 Go consortium, helping more than 100 public libraries share over 108,000 ebooks and audiobooks, and as an association management services provider for the Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services (ABOS), the Library Marketing and Communications Conference, the Louisiana Library Association (LLA), the Missouri Library Association (MLA), the Oklahoma Library Association (OLA), and other professional associations and networks across the region.

Several continued efforts have helped advance our focus on libraries and library staff.

Amigos' partnership with Skilltype marked a first of its kind investment in this new talent management platform. The partnership invited a pilot group of research libraries to begin deploying a data-driven approach to organizational development. The pilot program has grown to include the University of New Mexico, University of North Texas, and University of Oklahoma with original participants Rice University, Southern Methodist University, Texas Christian University, Texas Tech University, University of Texas at Arlington, The University of Texas at Austin, and Washington University in St. Louis. Amigos' consortium agreement with the National Information Standards Organization (NISO) provides NISO Library Standards Alliance (LSA) membership to all Amigos members, including free access to NISO's educational webinar program, unlimited participation in NISO Working Groups/Standing Committees, and discounted registration for events, including the annual NISO Plus conference. Finally, Amigos continues our record of popular and high-quality online training, including online topical conferences, the Annual Member Conference, Know & Go sessions (all free to members) and our discounted educational courses, attracting nearly 3,000 attendees and learners.

Our commitment to *organizational excellence* is evident in several new and continued efforts. Operational investments in ConsortiaManager have improved members' experiences with renewal and subscriptions through Amigos Member Discount Services program – including the free RDA Toolkit benefit that is part of Amigos membership. A new member portal, launching in the 2024–25 membership year, provides easy access for viewing current subscriptions, past invoices, and updating contacts at your library. The Trans-Amigos Express and Texpress courier services have experienced improvement in delivery and tracking following the development of a new label maker for participating libraries. And our core services – including the group purchasing program, courier service, and continuing education programs – continue to fulfill essential needs for libraries.

It continues to be a great pleasure to serve with the Amigos Board of Directors. I want to thank my fellow board members for their dedicated work and engagement. We thank you for your continued partnership and we look forward to more work ahead!

LIBRARIES SAVE THROUGH MEMBER DISCOUNT SERVICES

Through the Member Discount Services (MDS) group purchasing program, 365 libraries obtained specially negotiated member discounts on subscriptions to databases and journals from Amigos' vendor partners.

TRANS-AMIGOS EXPRESS AND TEXPRESS SUPPORT RESOURCE SHARING ACROSS THE **REGION**

Over 200,000 library items shipped through the Trans-Amigos Express (TAE) courier program in membership year 2023-24. With a flat-rate annual fee, TAE saved participants thousands of dollars on packaging and shipping while providing rapid pick-up and delivery of interlibrary loan materials.

TExpress, a partnership between the Texas State Library and Archives Commission and Amigos, provided courier service to 204 Texas libraries.

More than 303 Amigos member libraries participated in the Amigos Resource Sharing Agreement, accessing free loans and copies from member libraries and over 200 libraries in the South Central and Southwest regions of the United States.

MOLIB2GO MAKES EBOOKS ACCESSIBLE ACROSS MISSOURI PUBLIC **LIBRARIES**


The Amigos-administered Missouri Libraries 2 Go (MOLIB2GO) group, comprised of 119 public libraries with similar interests and patron populations, continued to work together to share a collection of over 108,000 ebooks and audiobooks. MOLIB2GO libraries checked out over 800,000 items in FY2024.

ALA RDA TOOLKIT BENEFITS MEMBER LIBRARIES

Over 180 member libraries accessed a free single-user sign-on to the ALA RDA Toolkit, an essential package of data elements, guidelines, and instructions for creating library resource metadata that are well-formed for user-focused linked data applications.

STAFF RECRUITMENT THROUGH AMIGOS JOB BANK

Posting openings on the Amigos Job Bank provides member libraries free access to a popular site with those searching for employment. Upwards of 330 positions at over 110 institutions received national visibility for openings reaching job seekers across the country.

AMIGOS EXTENDS NISO LIBRARY STANDARDS ALLIANCE MEMBERSHIP

Amigos' program with the National Information Standards Organization (NISO) extends Library Standards Alliance (LSA) membership to all member libraries, enhancing the value of Amigos membership with access to key benefits like continuing education and advocacy on critical issues of importance to libraries' futures.

Through LSA membership, Amigos libraries enjoyed free access to <u>NISO's educational webinars</u>, participation in <u>Working Groups/Committees</u>, and discounted registration for events, including the NISO Plus conference. In 2024, members accessed twelve free webinars and six discounted educational events.

As a NISO Voting Member, Amigos actively shapes the future of information management by voting on standards, best practices, and participating in NISO board elections.

ER&L AND NWILL CONFERENCE SPONSORSHIPS SUPPORT MEMBERS

Through sponsoring the 2024 Amigos Library Services Professional Development Award, Amigos provided free conference registration for the Camp Electronic Resources and Libraries (ER&L) 2024 Conference to staff from four libraries across the country — Kennesaw State University Libraries, Loyola University Chicago Libraries, Mid-Continent Public Library, and University of Texas Permian Basin.

With an exclusively designed sponsorship package, Amigos supported the Northwest Interlibrary Loan & Resource Sharing (NWILL) Conference, exhibiting at a virtual booth and providing five scholarships for staff from four Amigos member libraries to attend the conference. Scholarships were awarded to staff from member libraries at the University of Texas Permian Basin, Northeastern State University, Sul Ross State University, and the University of North Texas at Dallas.

AMIGOS SUPPORTS PROFESSIONAL AND LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT FOR ASSOCIATION CLIENTS

Amigos debuted its Library Association Leaders Learn & Share series, with the first session, "The Future is Now: Association Succession Planning," attended by nine association leaders. Event attendees discussed topics such as growing future association leaders, passing along institutional knowledge, and dealing with burnout at the association board level. Designed to give client association leaders an opportunity to come together to learn from each other, the online event series will continue to address relevant topics in library association leadership.

Amigos supported events and conferences for seven professional organizations, including the Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services; Library Marketing and Communications Conference; Louisiana Library Association, Missouri Library Association; Oklahoma Library Association; St. Louis Regional Library Network; and Wyoming Library Association.

DOAJ PARTNERSHIP SUPPORTS OPEN ACCESS

Amigos' partnership with the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) supported libraries in contributing to DOAJ's mission at discounted rates, helping sustain the independent open scholarship community-curated online directory of indexed, peer-reviewed resources.

Celebrating 20 years of promoting equity and diversity in scholarly communication in 2023, DOAJ reached a milestone of 20,000 indexed journals and launched new initiatives like the Open Access Journals Toolkit and PLACE, advancing best practices in open access publishing.

HYKU: A ROBUST AND FLEXIBLE DIGITAL REPOSITORY PLATFORM FOR INSTITUTIONS OF ANY SIZE

In 2023-24, Amigos began working with its Board of Directors to explore a new technology solution service for academic library members. Working with representatives from the Board of Directors — Barbara Glackin (Southeast Missouri State University), Tracey Mendoza (University of the Incarnate Word), Britt Anne Murphy (Hendrix College), Valerie Nye (Santa Fe Community College), and Paula Settoon (Tulsa Community College) — Amigos explored possible open-source technology solutions that would be of interest to smalland medium-sized academic libraries.

These discussions ultimately focused on the need for an affordable and scalable institutional repository solution, with Hyku emerging as a viable open-source solution. Hyku is a digital repository that provides a robust and flexible platform for institutions to manage and provide access to digital content. Providing easy-to-configure, feature-rich solutions, Hyku reduces barriers to effective asset management and is supported by a vibrant and ever-growing opensource community. The software is supported by an expanding community of academic libraries and consortia and builds on the Samvera Hyrax platform utilized by many larger institutions.

Over 2023-24, Amigos staff worked with selected member libraries to further explore Hyku, providing repositories for libraries to share and test with their staff. As Amigos moves forward to 2024-25, this work continues with the release of an improved Hyku 6.0, new opportunities for libraries to learn more about Hyku and Amigos' hosting service, and the launch of libraries' institutional repositories.

SIMPLYE MARKS SUCCESSES AND TRANSITIONS

October 2024 marks the end of Amigos' SimplyE hosting service – and a reflection on the successes and transitions of our efforts in this technology space.

SimplyE was conceived and built by libraries as an easy-to-use app bringing together a library's ebook and audiobook collections to allow patrons to more easily access their reading and listening materials. While improving discovery, SimplyE also upheld shared values including access, privacy, accessibility, and sustainable affordability through a commitment to open-source and collaborative technology solutions.

Over eight years, Amigos' involvement in the SimplyE project aligned our work with shared efforts and ambitions from the New York Public Library, Digital Public Library of America, and with our fellow consortia and library cooperatives, including Califa, Georgia Public Library Service, Lyrasis, Minitex, and others.

Amigos' SimplyE efforts included libraries working directly with Amigos and participants from state-wide initiatives, including the Texas State Library and Archives Commission's E-Read Texas Program and the Arizona State Library, Archives, and Public Records' initiative for tribal communities. In total, Amigos' work with SimplyE reached over 225 libraries from across the region – a network of partners that helped create the program's success.

SimplyE is just one in a series of Amigos' efforts to provide technology solutions for libraries. Pivoting away from one technology service, Amigos has undertaken a new opportunity to partner with libraries as a hosting provider for Hyku, a digital repository that provides a robust and flexible platform for institutions to manage and provide access to digital content.

AMIGOS SKILLTYPE PARTNERSHIP GROWS PILOT PROGRAM

Amigos' first of its kind investment with talent management platform <u>Skilltype</u>, invited a pilot group of research libraries to begin deploying a data-driven approach to organizational development last year. The pilot program has grown to include the University of New Mexico, University of North Texas, and University of Oklahoma with original participants Rice University, Southern Methodist University, Texas Christian University, Texas Tech University, University of Texas at Arlington, The University of Texas at Austin, and Washington University (WASHU) in St. Louis.

By leveraging Skilltype's library-specific platform, WASHU transformed its approach to talent management, gaining valuable insights into staff skills and interests. In a <u>case study</u>, the library shared how this new visibility enabled them to streamline career management and workforce development, offering targeted, cost-effective training, reducing reliance on traditional conferences.

After successful implementation of the pilot program, Skilltype joined the Amigos Discount Direct program, offering a 10% discount on subscriptions as a free benefit to Amigos members.
